## Methodical recommendations to the authors of the journal "Vestnik KRAUNTs. Nauki o Zemle"

The content of the article should correspond to one of the thematic sections of the journal. The title of the paper should reflect its content. The language of the article is Russian (see "Topics of the Journal and Rules for Authors"). The article should not contain materials that are not subject to publication in the open press.

The authors are responsible for the accuracy of the facts in the submissions. In the manuscript, all elements borrowed from other people's works (graphics, text, primary data) must be accompanied by appropriate references or permission of the copyright owner.

For the convenience of reading and perceiving the article, its text should be logically constructed and divided into sections. The following sections are mandatory.

"Introduction", which describes the object, goals and methods of research, gives a meaningful overview of the work done earlier by other researchers on the topic under consideration, formulates the problem to be solved in the article (its part, question, etc.).

"Materials" (source data), which sets out the data and facts on which the article is based.

"Research methods" with description of research methods, methods and technologies (techniques), enumeration and characteristics (if necessary) of used devices.

It is possible to combine the sections "Materials..." and "Methods..." into one.

"Results", which describes the actual data obtained, provides tables and graphical materials.

"Discussion of the results", which gives an interpretation of the data obtained, their significance for the solution of the problem set in the article, the ratio with the results of other researchers, including foreign ones.

It is possible to combine the sections "Results..." and "Discussion..." into one section "Results and Discussion".

The "Conclusions" section summarizes the results of the study.

"Reference list." Each reference in the article should correspond to the corresponding entry in the list of references, and vice versa - each of the works specified in the list should find a reference in the text of the article.

The article should be preceded by a 100-150-word abstract. The abstract summarizes the information about the aims (tasks) of the research, very briefly describes the data underlying the article, as well as the methods of obtaining and processing them, lists the main results and conclusions.

After the abstract, the key words (not more than eight) are given, which, in the opinion of the authors, most correctly indicate the specifics and content of the article and, thus, will ensure the effectiveness of its on-line search.

Signatures to the figures, names of tables and notes thereto, as well as references to Russian-language literary sources should be duplicated in English.

All abbreviations used in the article should be deciphered at the first mention, except for those that are generally accepted and understandable for non-specialists.
