

Methodical recommendations to reviewers of the journal "Vestnik KRAUNTs. Nauki o Zemle"

All the articles submitted to the editorial board of the journal are subject to mandatory one-sided "blind" review.

Reviewers can be both members of the editorial board and employees of the founding organization, and leading domestic and foreign specialists in the field, which is the subject of the reviewed work.

The review period should not exceed three weeks.

Reviewers in their work should be guided by the publication ethics of our journal, available at http://www.kscnet.ru/journal/public/journals/1/KRAESC_rules_ru.pdf

When writing a review, the reviewer should evaluate the compliance of the article with its title, the quality of the abstract, the scientific novelty of the work, the consistency of references in the article to the list of references, the quality of graphic materials. The reviewer may recommend the author to supplement the list of references or exclude some references from it, but should not offer the authors to supplement the list with their works, or works of their colleagues, if these works are not directly related to the problem considered in the work.

The reviewer should evaluate the logic of the submission and its relevance to the resolution of the problem.

The reviewer cannot involve his colleagues in writing the review unless it has been discussed with the editorial board of our journal in advance.

The reviewer should not address the authors of the material under review directly without the prior permission of the editorial board.

The reviewer should not impose a style of presentation on the author, and should also be sensitive in his work with authors for whom Russian is not their native language.

After reviewing the work, the reviewer gives his recommendations to the editorial board, indicating whether it is possible to publish an article in a journal, whether the article requires some revision or needs a major revision. Recommendations should be justified.
